- 30% Gibraltar Creeping Red Fescue
- 30% IQ Perennial Rygrass
- 20% Radar Chewing Fescue
- 20% Action Kentucky Bluegrass

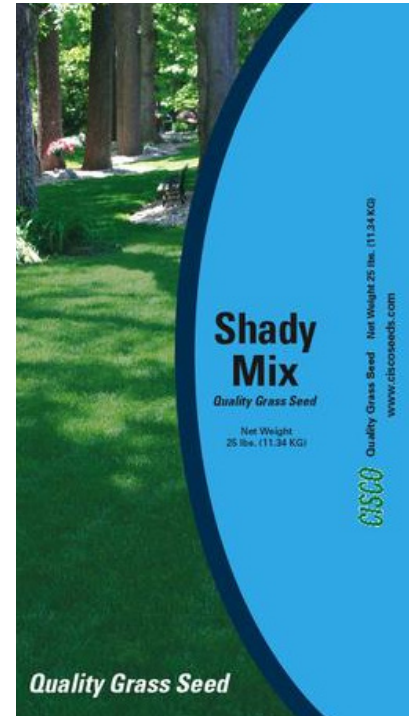
### NOTABLE CHARACTERISTICS

### NOTES ON PROPRIETARY FINE FESCUES:

Mixing fine fescues for shade tolerance is recommended by the Turf Department at Rutgers University. Fine Fescue varieties in Shady Mix are very shade tolerant, and very attractive. Fine Fescues used in Shady Mix also exhibit improved traffic tolerance. Varieties in Shady Mix provide excellent turf quality and improved disease resistance.
