2020 Do-It-Yourself Lawn Care

Got Ash borers or Japanese Beetles?
Early spring is the time to treat susceptible plants for these and other pests with Dominion Tree or Fruit Tree & Shrub.
32oz treats a 32" circumference tree

STEP 1: SPRING (LATE MARCH – MID APRIL)

- OPTION 1:** 19-0-0 w/ Dimension 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$24.95 / bag *Prevents crabgrass, broadleaf weeds and controls small emerged crabgrass up to the 1 tiller stage.
- OPTION 2:** 18-0-0 W/ Barricade 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$21.50 / bag *Long lasting residual control of crabgrass and broadleaf weeds. Must be applied before germination of weeds.
- OPTION 3:** 30-0-5 + 2% Iron 30% XCU 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$24.50 / bag *Slow release Nitrogen for longer feeding and Iron for a beautiful, quick green up. No herbicide, feeding only.

STEP 2: BROADLEAF CONTROL (LATE APRIL / MAY)

- OPTION 1:** Triad Select 16 oz. / 10,000 sq.ft. ** Pro formula for quick dandelion knockdown.
- OPTION 2:** Speedzone 18 oz. / 10,000 sq.ft. **Contains CARFENTRAZONE for excellent control of broadleaves especially clover and ground ivy.
- OPTION 3:** 2DQ 10 oz / 10,000 sq.ft. **Contains QUINCLORAC for control of thistles, dandelion, clover and many other broadleaf weeds.

STEP 3: SUMMER (JUNE / JULY)

OPTION 1: 30-0-5 + 2% Iron 30% XCU 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$24.50 / bag

*Slow release Nitrogen for longer feeding and Iron for a beautiful, quick green up. Pesticide Free.

OPTION 2: 18-0-3 w/ Protego 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$28.95 / bag

*Contains IMIDACLOPRID for SYSTEMIC control of **GRUBS** + other insects **PLUS** Lamba Cyhalothrin for **TICKS, FLEAS, SPIDERS**, etc. Apply late June/early July. Needs rain or irrigation to move product into soil for best results.

OPTION 3: 24-0-3 W/ Fe & Micros 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$23.95 / bag

* Extended Release containing Iron and Micronutrients.

OPTION 4: GRUB FREE ZONE III 14.3# / 10,000 sq.ft.

*Contains IMIDACLOPRID for Systemic control of grubs.

STEP 4: LATE SUMMER BROADLEAF CONTROL (SEPTEMBER / OCTOBER)

OPTION 1: BROADLEAF CONTROL (SEE OTHER SIDE STEP 2)

OPTION 2: OVERSEEDING THIN AREAS. SEE LAWN SEEDING GUIDE.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS:

*Do not spray weeds when temps are below 45 degrees

*Do not overseed after application until you have mowed 4 times

STEP 5: FALL WINTERIZER (OCTOBER / NOVEMBER)

OPTION 1: 30-0-5 + 2% Fe 30% XCU 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$24.50 / bag

*Feed and grow turf roots. 30% stabilized Nitrogen.

OPTION 2: 10-20-8 W/ UMAXX 50# / 12,500 sq.ft. \$19.95 / bag

*13% UMAXX stabilized Nitrogen, contains Topcut Organics, *PERFECT for newly seeded lawns also.*

OPTION 3 : 6-24-24 50# / 8,000 sq.ft. \$19.95 / bag
