



How to Apply

It is wise to always calibrate your spreader before each use. When in doubt, set your spreader so the shut-off plate is less than one half open. Smaller sized particles (Greens Grade) will require lower settings. This product may stain sidewalks, patios, driveways, pool liners and other surfaces. Immediately sweep off or remove any product that may have been misapplied to unwanted areas.



Rotary Spreaders:

First do two “header” strips around the perimeter, then spread back and forth between the headers. To avoid missing areas, always overlap.



Bulk Broadcast Spreaders:

Begin by forming “headers” to differentiate target and non-target areas. Then, spread back and forth inside target turning on and off spreader between headers until entire area is treated.

CALIBRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

To provide proper distribution, calibrate spreader before application.

- For 3.0 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet of turfgrass: Check your spreader on 333 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 pound of product per 333 square feet.
- For 3.6 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet of turfgrass: Check your spreader on 275 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 pound of product per 275 square feet.
- **For 4.0 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet of turfgrass:** Check your spreader on 250 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 pound of product per 250 square feet.

DISTRIBUTION AND SPREADER SETTINGS:

Always apply with a properly calibrated rotary or drop type fertilizer spreader to distribute the granules evenly. Never apply by hand.

Coverage—To determine how much you need to apply, multiply the length of your lawn by its width. This equals your total square footage. Deduct all non-lawn areas (house, garden, etc.). One 20 pound bag of Endure covers 5,000 square feet. One 50 pound bag of Endure covers 12,500 square feet.

SINGLE PASS DISTRIBUTION:

For best results, apply this product evenly and uniformly avoiding streaking, skips, or overlaps.

1. For rotary spreaders, operate at intervals corresponding to the swath width. For drop spreaders, overlap the wheel tracks to ensure complete coverage.
2. First, spread the borders of the lawn. Then apply this product to the center with straight line passes.
3. Walk at a steady pace to ensure even coverage. Close the spreader opening when turning to change directions or when stopping.
